## SECTION 1

SECTION 3.2 ENTITLED "BASIS FOR ESTABLISHING THE AREAS OF SPECIAL FLOOD HAZ-ARDS IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) The areas of special flood hazard have been identified by the Federal Emergency management Agency on Flood Insurance Rate Maps enumerated on Map Index No. 361136B 01-10 dated January 3, 1985.
- (2) The above documents are hereby adopted and declared to be a part of this local law and are filed at the Supervisor's office.

## SECTION 2

- SECTION 6.1 ENTITLED "APPEALS BOARD" SUBDIVISIONS 1 THROUGH AND INCLUDING 6 IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
- (1) The Town Board of Assessment Review, as established by the Town of Stratford shall hear and decide appeals and requests for variances from the requirements of this Local Law.
- (2) The Town Board of Assessment Review shall hear and decide appeals when it is alleged there is an error in any requirement, decision, or determination made by the Local Administrator in the enforcement for administration of this Local Law.
- (3) Those aggrieved by the decision of the Town Board of Assessment Review may appeal such decision to the Supreme Court, pursuant to Article 78 of the Civil Practice Law and Rules.
- (4) In passing upon such application, the Town Board of Assessment Review shall consider all technical evaluations, all relevant factors, standards specified in other sections of this local law and:
  - (i) The danger that materials may be swept onto other lands to the injury of others;
  - (ii) The danger to life and property due to flooding or erosion damage;
  - (iii) The susceptibility of the proposed facility and its contents to flood damage and the effect of such damage on the individual owner;
  - (iv) the importance of the services provided by the proposed facility to the community.
  - (v) The necessity to the facility of a waterfront location, where applicable;
    - (vi) The availability of alternative locations for

the proposed use which are not subject to flooding or erosion damage.

- (vii) The compatibility of the proposed use with existing and anticipated development;
- (viii) The relationship of the proposed use to the comprehensive plan and flood plain management program of that area;
- (ix) The safety of access to the property in times of flood for ordinary and emergency vehicles.
- (x) The costs to local governments and the dangers associated with conducting search and rescue operations during periods of flooding.
- (xi) The expected heights, velocity, duration, rate of rise, and sediment transport of the flood waters and the effects of wave action, if applicable, expected at the site, and
- (xii) The costs of providing governmental services during and after flood conditions, including search and rescue operations, maintenance and repair of public utilities and facilities such as sewer, gas, electrical and water systems and streets and bridges.

## SECTION 3

This Local Law is Corrective and Amendatory and shall not be subject to a referendum, and shall become effective on compliance with all of the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law applicable thereto and upon the filing thereof with the Secretary of State.
